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MINUTES OF MARCH 8, 2018 COMMISSION MEETING

OPEN SESSION

1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m., and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Roll Call of Commissioners

Roll Call of Commissioners was taken with Chairman Jim Evans, Commissioner Paula LaBrie, and Commissioner Trang To present.

Upon motion of Commissioner LaBrie, seconded by Commissioner To, and unanimously carried in a vote by roll call with Chairman Evans, Commissioner LaBrie, and Commissioner To voting yes; the Commission approved the Commission Meeting Minutes for January 11, 2018 and January 25, 2018.

Chairman Evans welcomed the new Director of the Bureau of Gambling Control, Stephanie Shimazu. Commissioner LaBrie and Commissioner To also welcomed Director Shimazu and mentioned they are looking forward to working with her.

Director Shimazu responded that she also is looking forward to working with the Bureau and the Commission.

4. <u>California Problem Gambling Treatment Services Program, Overview & Update:</u> Presenter: Terri Sue Canale-Dalman, Chief, Office of Problem Gambling, California Department of Public Health

Chief Canale-Dalman presented on the progress and updates for the Office of Problem Gambling. Chief Canale-Dalman provided Problem Gambling Treatment Program statistics, and discussed how the prevention program is moving in a new direction with a much lighter and personal tone. Chief Canale-Dalman noted the results have been very positive. The program has consolidated the helplines of 1-800-GAMBLER, and can provide services in 200 different languages and dialects 24 hours a day.

Chief Canale-Dalman reported that in fiscal year of 2016-2017, there were over 24,000 calls to the helpline, 153 text conversations, and a live chat was also implemented to assist those affected by gambling problems. Chief Canale-Dalman further reported that Problem Gambling staff has provided training and technical assistance to over 300,000 non-profit staff, health professionals, educators, law enforcement, and gambling industry personal. Chief Canale-Dalman discussed that a study of self-excluded patrons recently commenced and more than twenty cardrooms are participating, wherein outcomes are anticipated in 2019. Chief Canale-Dalman further discussed the collaboration between her office and the industry as well.

Ms. Canale-Dalman provided a brief history and provided statistics with regard to treatment provided by the California Gambling Education and Treatment Services Program (CalGETS). Ms. Canale-Dalman discussed the California Problem Gambling Training Summit that will be held March 21, 2018 to March 22, 2018.

Chairman Evans, Commissioner LaBrie, and Commissioner To all commented on the great work that Ms. Canale-Dalman and others are doing for gambling patrons and the industry.
